

Surcharges that may apply:

- 1) Tack charges from \$25.00 for small trunk or saddle to \$100.00 for large or heavy trunk or saddle.
- 2) Waiting time spent on location will be charged an additional \$50.00 per hour, after 30 minutes.
- 3) "Difficult Loaders" will incur an additional \$50.00 per hour fee, after 30 minutes of attempting to load or unload.
- 4) Any damage caused by the said horse(s), during loading/unloading and/or hauling will be added to current balance.
- 5) In the event we are unable to transport due to incomplete paperwork, misrepresentation, or inability to safely load after considerable effort, 50% of the fee will be retained.
- 6) Additional surcharges may apply if difficult roads are not disclosed at time of original quote, and will be dependent on difficulty of road(s) and additional time required to arrive at destination.
- 7) Additional charge for pick-up/delivery may apply if location is different from that quoted.

Insurance:

Transporter carries vehicle liability insurance. Shipper is responsible to maintain and provide proof of Horse Mortality Insurance, if desired. If Shipper does not carry insurance, he/she assumes all risks.

**Cancellation:**

A \$50.00 processing fee may be enforced if Shipper should cancel guaranteed transport 3 days or more prior to scheduled shipping date; a \$100.00 processing fee should the Shipper cancel guaranteed transport less than 3 days prior to scheduled shipping date.

In the event of Transporter vehicle/equipment malfunction, efforts will be made to find alternate transport options, or possible rescheduling.

**The Transporter Agrees:**

- 1) Transporter agrees to provide services to Shipper as described under contract, in the equipment as provided herein, at the rates set forth herein.
- 2) Transporter will follow out as closely and as reasonably as possible the delivery instructions.
- 3) Delivery of said horse(s) will be evident by a pick-up & delivery invoice, signed by the Transporter, Shipper and Consignee (or their agents/employees) at the loading and unloading locations.
- 4) Transporter will diligently make effort to safely and properly transport, feed and care for said horse(s), but does not guarantee the health or physical condition of said horse(s) upon departure or arrival.
- 5) Diligent effort will be made to pick-up and deliver said horse(s) on suggested dates/times. Transporter is not held liable for delays caused by detours, threat of bad traveling weather, poor road conditions, or emergency health needs that take place en route. Transporter will maintain contact with Shipper throughout delays.
- 6) Transporter will immediately notify Shipper if said horse(s) require services of a Veterinarian. In the event the Shipper cannot be reached, the Transporter is hereby authorized as an agent for the Shipper, to call an available licensed Veterinarian of his choice. Shipper will be responsible for any Veterinary fees incurred, and Transporter will not be held liable for such fees.
